Contest Guidelines

Artwork:

- Create a picture to show what makes your school green, or how your school could be green
 - Use paper or card stock, up to size 12 x 18
- Any medium can be used: paint, crayons, pencil, collage, photos, stencils, etc.
 - We encourage the use of recycled paper
 - Please no glitter or copyright or trademark images
- Do not include the student's or school's name within the artwork
 - Do not include matting or framing with submission
 - Individual entries only

Judging Criteria:

- Concept: Does it communicate the theme or message?
 - Creativity: Is the art original and unique?
 - Quality: Is there effective use of materials?

Deadline & Submission:

Submissions by email or mail.

Online submissions are due Earth Day, Monday, April 22, 2013, 5 p.m. EDT
